

HOUSE No. 78

Accompanying the second recommendation of the Division of Metropolitan Planning (House, No. 76). Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

Resolve providing for an Investigation by the Department of Public Works and the Division of Metropolitan Planning relative to the Construction and Improvement of Certain Highways within the Metropolitan District.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works
2 and the division of metropolitan planning are hereby
3 directed to consider jointly the advisability, feasi-
4 bility, and probable cost of improving highway con-
5 ditions by the construction of highways and bridges
6 as follows: —

7 (1) A highway extending from the Furnace Brook
8 Parkway east of the point where said parkway
9 passes under the Granite division of the New York,
10 New Haven and Hartford railroad, over public and
11 private lands and public and private ways in a gen-
12 eral easterly direction to Washington street, Quincy,
13 at a point westerly of the Fore River bridge;

14 (2) A highway extending from the Southern
15 Artery near Edison street in the city of Quincy
16 easterly to Washington street near the westerly ap-
17 proach of the Fore River bridge;

18 (3) A highway or parkway extending northwest-
19 erly from the Wollaston Boulevard near its junction
20 with East Squantum street to a point on the Old
21 Colony Boulevard to be selected by the department
22 and the division.

23 (4) A continuation of the outer circumferential
24 highway in part authorized by chapter four hundred
25 and twenty of the acts of nineteen hundred and
26 thirty from its northerly terminus at Worcester
27 street in the town of Wellesley through Newton,
28 Watertown, Waltham, Lexington, Woburn, Stone-
29 ham, Wakefield and Lynnfield to the Newburyport
30 Turnpike.

31 Said department and said division shall report
32 jointly to the General Court their findings and
33 recommendations, if any, together with drafts of
34 legislation necessary to carry such recommendations
35 into effect by filing the same with the clerk of the
36 Senate on or before the first Wednesday in Decem-
37 ber in the year nineteen hundred and thirty-one, and
38 shall at the same time file a copy of said report
39 with the budget commissioner.
