The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

Resolve providing for an Investigation and Report by the Department of Public Utilities relative to the Control of Certain Railroads in this Commonwealth.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public utilities
2 is hereby authorized and directed to investigate to
3 what extent, if any, the Pennsylvania Railroad
4 Company and/or the Pennroad Corporation has,
5 directly or indirectly, acquired domination or con-
6 trol of, or a substantial interest in, the Boston and
7 Maine railroad and the New York, New Haven
8 and Hartford Railroad Company, the amount of
9 such ownership, direct or indirect, the consideration
10 paid in acquiring the same, the amount of securities
11 issued against such ownership and the returns from
12 the investment. Said department shall report to
13 the general court the results of its investigation by
14 filing the same with the clerk of the house of repre-
15 sentatives on or before December first in the cur-
16 rent year.
