An Act relative to the Physical Examination of Applicants for Employment in the Labor Service of Cities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section three of chapter thirty-one of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by adding at the end
3 thereof the following: — provided, however, no such
4 rule or regulation shall require the physical examina-
5 tion of applicants for the position of laborer within
6 any city unless the city government of said city re-
7 quests such examinations to be made.
