

HOUSE No. 205

By Mr. Lewis R. Sullivan, Jr., of Boston, petition of M. A. O'Brien, Jr., that the Department of Public Works be authorized to construct paths or sidewalks and curbings along state highways. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act authorizing the Department of Public Works to construct Paths or Sidewalks and Curbing along State Highways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. In addition to the powers conferred
2 upon the state highway commission it shall be law-
3 ful, and the commission is hereby authorized and
4 empowered, to construct paths or sidewalks and
5 curbing along state highways and other roads and
6 highways, subject to the jurisdiction of the commis-
7 sion, from any moneys available to said commis-
8 sion; and further is empowered in connection with
9 such construction, as aforesaid, to enter into agree-
10 ments with counties and other municipalities to
11 share the cost of such construction, and thereafter
12 of the maintenance and construction of such paths,
13 sidewalks and curbings so constructed.

1 SECTION 2. This act to take effect immediately
2 after its passage.
