By Mr. Pratt of Saugus, petition of Frank W. Osborne and C. F. Nelson Pratt for an investigation by the Armory Commissioners relative to the construction of a new state armory or of an addition to the existing state armory in the city of Lynn. Military Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

Resolve providing for an Investigation by the Armory Commissioners relative to the Construction of a New State Armory in the City of Lynn, or the Construction of an Addition to the Existing State Armory therein.

1 *Resolved*, That the armory commissioners are
2 hereby directed to investigate relative to the de-
3 sirability, necessity and expediency of the construc-
4 tion by the commonwealth in the city of Lynn of
5 a new state armory, or of an addition to the exist-
6 ing state armory therein, for the use of the militia,
7 to replace or supplement said existing armory, and
8 the location and probable cost thereof, including
9 the cost of acquiring such land as may be necessary.
10 Said commissioners are hereby further directed to
11 report to the general court their conclusions and
12 recommendations, if any, with drafts of legislation
13 necessary to carry such recommendations into effect,
14 by filing the same with the clerk of the senate
15 not later than December first in the current year.
