By Mr. Squires of Worcester, petition of the Department of Massachusetts, United Spanish War Veterans, and the Department of Massachusetts, Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, that the Secretary of the Commonwealth be authorized to compile and print the laws of the Commonwealth relating to veteran soldiers and sailors and their organizations. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

Resolve providing for Compiling and Printing the Laws of the Commonwealth relating to Veterans and their Organizations.

1 *Resolved*, That the state secretary shall cause the
2 laws of the commonwealth relating to veterans,
3 and to their organizations, to be compiled, indexed
4 and annotated, and shall cause to be printed in
5 pamphlet form an edition of not more than ten
6 thousand copies of such compilation, and shall dis-
7 tribute them as follows: To such free public libraries
8 of the commonwealth as the state secretary shall
9 designate, to such other free public libraries as shall
10 make written application therefor, to each post,
11 camp or other organization of such veterans within
12 the commonwealth, and to the national headquarters
13 of such organizations, one copy each; to the head-
14 quarters of the Massachusetts Departments of the
15 Grand Army of the Republic, The American Legion,

16 the United Spanish War Veterans and the Veterans
17 of Foreign Wars of the United States, not exceeding
18 one hundred copies each. The remaining copies
19 shall be distributed by the state secretary in the
20 manner provided for the distribution of public docu-
21 ments. To carry out the provisions of this resolve,
22 the state secretary may expend such amount, not
23 exceeding six hundred and fifty dollars, as the gen-
24 eral court may appropriate.
