Resolve providing for an Investigation and Report relative to Removing or Altering the Subway Incline on Cambridge Street in the City of Boston.

1 *Resolved*, The transit department of the city of
2 Boston is hereby directed to inquire into the expedi-
3 ency and desirability of removing or altering the
4 two track subway incline on Cambridge street in
5 the city of Boston to provide greater roadway area
6 on said street, and with reference to its effect on
7 traffic and otherwise. Said study shall be in suffi-
8 cient detail so as to include a reliable estimate as
9 to the cost of said removal or alterations, the man-
10 ner in which the cost should be apportioned, and
11 the manner of paying for same, and the effect, if
12 any, said removal or alteration will have upon the
13 rentals from the East Boston tunnel, together with
14 the plans of any proposed alterations. Said depart-
15 ment shall report to the general court its findings
16 and recommendations together with drafts of legis-
17 lation necessary to carry its recommendations into
18 effect by filing the same with the clerk of the house
19 of representatives not later than the first Wednesday
20 of December in the current year.
