By Mr. Kirkpatrick of Holyoke, petition of William E. Kirkpatrick that cities and towns be authorized to appropriate money for insuring motor vehicles owned and controlled by them. Municipal Finance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act to allow Cities and Towns to insure Motor Vehicles Owned and Controlled by them.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section five of chapter forty of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by inserting after number one
3 in such section a new clause, to read as follows: —

4 (1a) To pay proper and reasonable expense of
5 an insurance company for placing motor vehicle
6 liability insurance on motor vehicles owned and
7 controlled by any city or town.
