An Act to regulate Gliding and the Use of Gliders.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter ninety of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following
3 new section: —

4 *Section 61.* The registrar may prepare rules and
5 regulations from time to time, governing gliding and
6 the use and operation of gliders. Such rules and
7 regulations shall at all times conform to the federal
8 laws and regulations relative thereto. No fee shall
9 be required for any license for gliding or the regis-
10 tration of any glider.

The Committee on the Judiciary, to which the bill was referred, has the honor to report the same with amendments, and to recommend its passage.
