

HOUSE No. 315

By Mr. Shepard of Shrewsbury, petition of Howard S. Shepard that the Commonwealth reimburse certain cities and towns in the counties of Worcester and Middlesex for expenses incurred in connection with the reconstruction of the Boston and Worcester Turnpike, Highways and Motor Vehicles.
