## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act to provide for an Additional Associate Medical Examiner in District Two in Barnstable County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter thirty-eight, section one, of  
2 the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out  
3 the second paragraph of said section one, and insert-  
4 ing the following in place thereof:—

5 Two examiners and two associate examiners in  
6 Suffolk county, and one associate examiner in Nan-  
7 tucket county and in each of the following districts:

8 Except that District Two, Barnstable, Bourne,  
9 Sandwich, Mashpee and Falmouth shall have two  
10 associate examiners instead of one,—so that said  
11 section one as thus amended shall read as follows:—

12 The governor, with the advice and consent of the  
13 council, shall appoint for terms of seven years able  
14 and discreet men, learned in the science of medicine,

15 as medical examiners in and for their respective  
16 counties, and as associate medical examiners in and  
17 for their respective districts in counties divided into  
18 districts, otherwise in and for their respective coun-  
19 ties, in number as follows:

20 Two examiners and two associate examiners in  
21 Suffolk county, and one examiner and one associate  
22 examiner in Nantucket county and each of the fol-  
23 lowing districts:

24 Except that district two, Barnstable, Bourne,  
25 Sandwich, Mashpee and Falmouth, shall have two  
26 associate examiners instead of one.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
