

By Mr. McCarthy of Rockland, petition of Coleman E. Kelly that the Commissioner of Corporations and Taxation be authorized to levy a tax on sales of radios, radio parts and patent medicines for the purposes of the fund for paying old age assistance to needy persons. Taxation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act relative to the Fund for Old Age Pensions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commissioner of taxation is hereby
2 authorized to levy a tax of five cents on all sales of
3 radios, radio tubes and parts, and on all patent medi-
4 cines sold within the commonwealth of Massachu-
5 setts.

1 SECTION 2. The said tax levy shall be added to
2 the fund for Old Age Pensions and shall not be used
3 for any other purpose. Upon the passage of this
4 act, the commissioner of taxation shall serve notice
5 upon all dealers of radios, radio tubes and parts,
6 and dealers of patent medicines in the commonwealth,
7 of the provisions of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
