

HOUSE No. 341

By Mr. Jones of Barnstable, petition of the Park Commissioners of the town of Falmouth that said town be authorized to erect on park land a bath house and maintain a public bathing place. Towns.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act to authorize the Town of Falmouth to erect a Bath House and to establish and maintain a Certain Public Bathing Place.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Falmouth is hereby
2 authorized to erect a bath house, exceeding six
3 hundred square feet in area on the ground, upon
4 certain property owned by the town and used for
5 park purposes, being commonly known as Old Silver
6 Beach park.

1 SECTION 2. The town of Falmouth is hereby
2 authorized to establish and maintain a public bath-
3 ing beach at said Old Silver Beach park and to make
4 such changes in said property for this purpose, and
5 to furnish such equipment and appliances, as may
6 be necessary. The board of park commissioners of
7 said town, and any board which may hereafter suc-

8 ceed it, may make such rules and regulations for the
9 conduct of said bathing place, and may establish such
10 rates for the use of the bath house or houses as they
11 may consider necessary.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
