By Mr. Williams of Wellesley, petition of Harold L. Niles and others, selectmen, that the office of chief engineer of the board of fire engineers of the town of Wellesley be placed under the civil service laws. Civil Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act subjecting the Office of the Chief Engineer of the Board of Fire Engineers of the Town of Wellesley to the Civil Service Laws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The office of the chief engineer of
2 the board of fire engineers of the town of Wellesley
3 shall, upon the effective date of this act, become
4 subject to the civil service laws and rules and regu-
5 lations relating to permanent members of fire depart-
6 ments of towns, and the term of office of any incum-
7 bent thereof shall be unlimited, except that he may
8 be removed in accordance with such laws and rules
9 and regulations; but the person holding said office
10 on said effective date may continue therein without
11 taking a civil service examination.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by a majority of the voters of the town
3 of Wellesley present and voting thereon at any special
4 or regular town meeting; and for the purpose only
5 of being submitted to the voters of said town as afore-
6 said, this act shall take effect upon its passage.
