

By Mr. Murphy of Boston, petition of John F. Murphy and Leo M. Birmingham that the city of Boston be authorized to reinstate James E. McCarthy as a member of its police department. Civil Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act authorizing the Reinstatement of James E. McCarthy as a Member of the Police Department of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. James E. McCarthy, a former member
2 of the police department of the city of Boston, who
3 was discharged therefrom on November eighteen,
4 nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, may be rein-
5 stated in said department without further examina-
6 tion, and, upon said reinstatement he shall be en-
7 titled to the same pension and retirement rights as if
8 his term of service in said department had not been
9 interrupted by said discharge.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance during the current year by the mayor and
3 city council of said city, in accordance with the pro-
4 visions of its charter.
