

By Mr. Finkelstein of Boston, petition of James M. Curley, mayor, that the city of Boston be authorized to borrow money for the purpose of extending the covered channel of Stony Brook and the Canterbury and Roslindale branches thereof in said city. Municipal Finance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act providing for the Extension of the Covered Channel of Stony Brook and the Canterbury and Roslindale Branches of Stony Brook.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of extending the
2 covered channel of Stony Brook and the Canter-
3 bury and Roslindale branches of Stony Brook, or
4 either of them, in such direction or directions as the
5 commissioner of public works of the city of Boston
6 shall determine, subject to the approval of the mayor,
7 the city of Boston may borrow outside the statutory
8 limit of indebtedness from time to time the sum of
9 not exceeding two million dollars and may issue
10 bonds or notes therefor, which shall bear on their
11 face the words "Stony Brook Channel Improvement
12 Loan, Act of 1931". Each authorized issue shall
13 constitute a separate loan and such loans shall be
14 paid in not more than thirty years from their date.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of the
3 city council of said city, subject to the provisions of
4 its charter.
