

HOUSE No. 367

By Mr. Sawyer of Ware (by request), petition of Charles H. Morrill that the control of Plug Pond or Lake Saltonstall in the city of Haverhill be transferred from the water commissioners to the municipal council of said city. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act relative to the Control and Maintenance of Plug Pond in the City of Haverhill.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The powers and duties granted to and
2 imposed upon the city of Haverhill by chapter three
3 hundred and forty-eight of the acts of the year eighteen
4 hundred and ninety-one, and by chapter four hundred
5 and seventeen of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
6 and ninety-two as amended by chapter four hundred
7 and thirty-three of the acts of the year eighteen hun-
8 dred and ninety-six and amendments thereto, insofar
9 as said acts and amendments thereto relate to Plug
10 pond, sometimes called Lake Saltonstall, shall be
11 exercised by the municipal council of said city exclu-
12 sively and land owned by said city within the water
13 shed of said pond shall be managed, improved and

14 controlled by said municipal council in such a manner
15 as they shall deem for the best interests of the said
16 city.

1 SECTION 2. The said municipal council may, if in
2 their judgment the said pond and its waters are not
3 necessary for a source of water supply, use and main-
4 tain said pond and its waters for recreational purposes,
5 authorized by law, until the first day of January in the
6 year nineteen hundred and forty.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by a majority vote of the municipal council
3 of the said city of Haverhill.
