Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 After an appropriation therefor has been made, the
2 metropolitan district commission shall construct, at a
3 cost not to exceed dollars, and shall
4 thereafter operate, an aviation beacon light on the
5 tower located on Bellevue hill, so called, in the West
6 Roxbury district of the city of Boston.
