By Mr. Bruce of Everett, petition of Michael C. O'Neill, mayor, that the city of Everett be authorized to establish a department of soldiers' relief and state and military aid. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act to provide for the City of Everett a Department of Soldiers' Relief and State and Military Aid under the Direction of a Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. In the city of Everett, there shall be
2 a department of soldiers' relief and state and military
3 aid under the direction of a commissioner to be ap-
4 pointed as provided in section two.

1 SECTION 2. The mayor of said city shall, as soon
2 as may be after the passage of this act and annually
3 thereafter in the month of January, subject to con-
4 firmation by the board of aldermen, appoint a com-
5 missioner of soldiers' relief and state and military aid,
6 who shall perform all duties imposed by law relative
7 to the payment and disbursement of state aid, military
8 aid and soldiers' relief. Every such commissioner
9 shall be appointed to serve for a term of one year and

10 until the qualification of his successor, except the one
11 first appointed, who shall serve only until the qualifi-
12 cation of his successor.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
