

HOUSE No. 618

By Mr. Sparrell of Norwell, petition of Joseph G. Bryer that the authority of the town of Marshfield to furnish water to the Scituate Water Company be conditioned on the payment by the latter of an adequate sum of money to the Humarock Beach Water Company. Water Supply.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act relative to the Supplying of Water by the Town of Marshfield to the Scituate Water Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section two of chapter four hundred
2 and nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty
3 is hereby amended by striking out section two and
4 inserting in place thereof the following:—
5 *Section 2.* The authority granted by section one
6 is hereby conditioned upon the payment by the
7 Scituate Water Company to the Humarock Beach
8 Water Company of such amount as may be deter-
9 mined to be the fair value of the tangible property
10 of said Humarock Beach Water Company perma-
11 nently located within the town of Scituate. Said
12 amount to be thus paid shall be finally determined
13 by a board of three appraisers, prior to April first,
14 nineteen hundred and thirty-one, one to be named

15 by each company and the two thus chosen to select
16 a third; provided, however, that if said Humarock
17 Beach Water Company fails to name an appraiser
18 as aforesaid, prior to March first, nineteen hundred
19 and thirty-one, the provisions of this section shall
20 become null and void.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
