An Act to change the Membership of the Board of Trustees of Milton Academy.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section five of "An Act for establishing an  
2 academy in the Town of Milton, by the name of  
3 Milton Academy," approved March third, seven-  
4 teen hundred and ninety-eight, as amended by chap-  
5 ter two hundred and eight, section two of the acts  
6 of nineteen hundred, is further amended by striking  
7 out the word "fifteen" in the second line and in-  
8 serting in place thereof the word:—eighteen,—so  
9 as to read as follows:—*Section 5. Be it further*  
10 *enacted,* That the number of said trustees shall not,  
11 at one time, be more than eighteen nor less than  
12 nine; five of whom shall constitute a quorum to do  
13 business.
