By Mr. Lane of Lawrence (by request), petition of R. C. Leed for legislation to assure the payment of medical expenses in the settlement of damages under the law relating to the compulsory liability insurance of motor vehicles. Judiciary (Joint).

An Act to assure the Payment of Medical Expenses in the Settlement of Damage Cases under the Compulsory Insurance Law, so-called.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section thirty-four A of chapter ninety, as most
2 recently amended by section one of chapter three
3 hundred and forty of the acts of nineteen hundred
4 and thirty, is hereby further amended by adding at
5 the end thereof the following: — The insurer shall
6 in all cases in which claims are paid make sure that
7 the physicians or surgeons who treat any person so
8 injured are compensated for their services.
