**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act to permit the Use of a Portion of Bell Rock Memorial Park in the City of Malden for the Purpose of Constructing and Maintaining a Building for the Use and Benefit of Certain Organizations of Veterans.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The board of park commissioners of the city of  
2 Malden is hereby authorized to set aside and allow  
3 the use of a portion of certain park land located  
4 in the city of Malden and known as Bell Rock  
5 Memorial park for the purpose of constructing a  
6 building to be maintained by said city for the use  
7 and benefit of organizations of veterans who have  
8 served in military and naval forces of the United  
9 States in time of war.

10 There shall be used therefor so much of said park  
11 as shall be designated for that purpose by the board  
12 of park commissioners of the said city by a vote  
13 of two thirds of the members. A plan of the park  
14 showing the part set off as aforesaid shall be made  
15 and kept on file in the office of the park commis-  
16 sioners.
