

HOUSE No. 1042

By Mr. MacLeod of Chelsea, petition of John W. MacLeod that the office of clerk of committees of the board of aldermen of the city of Chelsea be placed under the civil service laws. Civil Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act subjecting the Office of Clerk of Committees of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Chelsea to the Civil Service Laws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The office of clerk of committees of
2 the board of aldermen of the city of Chelsea shall,
3 upon the effective date of this act, become subject
4 to the civil service laws and rules and regulations,
5 and the term of office of any incumbent thereof
6 shall be unlimited, except that he may be removed
7 in accordance with such laws and rules and regula-
8 tions; but the person holding said office on said ef-
9 fective date may continue therein without taking a
10 civil service examination.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for ac-
2 ceptance to the registered voters of the city of
3 Chelsea at its next regular city election in the form

4 of the following question which shall be placed
5 upon the official ballot to be used at said election:
6 "Shall an act passed by the general court in the
7 year nineteen hundred and thirty-one, entitled 'An
8 Act subjecting the office of clerk of committees of
9 the board of aldermen of the city of Chelsea to the
10 civil service laws', be accepted?" If a majority
11 of the voters voting thereon vote in the affirmative
12 in answer to said question, this act shall thereupon
13 take effect, but not otherwise.
