

HOUSE No. 1173

By Mr. Murphy of Boston, petition of John F. Murphy and another for increasing the territorial jurisdiction of the municipal court of the Brighton district of the city of Boston. Judiciary (Joint).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act to increase the Territorial Jurisdiction of the
Municipal Court of the Brighton District.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one of chapter two hundred and eighteen of
2 the General Laws, as most recently amended by
3 section one of chapter one hundred and thirty-two
4 of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty, is hereby
5 further amended by adding at the end of the para-
6 graph included in lines one hundred and forty-eight
7 to one hundred and fifty, inclusive, as printed in the
8 General Laws, the following: —, together with that
9 part of Boston heretofore under the jurisdiction of
10 the municipal court of the Roxbury district, as herein
11 described, to wit: — commencing at a point on the
12 southerly bank of the Charles river basin at Ashby
13 street; thence along the easterly side of Ashby street
14 and St. Mary's street to a point on the extension of

15 St. Mary's street where it intersects the riverway,
16 so called; thence along the northerly and easterly
17 line of said riverway and the easterly line of Louis
18 Prang street to Huntington avenue; thence along the
19 northerly side of Huntington avenue to its intersection
20 with Massachusetts avenue; thence northerly along
21 the westerly side of Massachusetts avenue to the
22 Charles river basin; thence along the Charles river
23 basin to the point of beginning, — so as to read as
24 follows:— The municipal court of the Brighton dis-
25 trict, held at Brighton in Boston; ward twenty-five
26 of Boston as it existed on February first, eighteen
27 hundred and eighty-two, together with that part of
28 Boston heretofore under the jurisdiction of the
29 municipal court of the Roxbury district, as herein
30 described, to wit: commencing at a point on the
31 southerly bank of the Charles river basin at Ashby
32 street; thence along the easterly side of Ashby
33 street and St. Mary's street to a point on the exten-
34 sion of St. Mary's street where it intersects the river-
35 way, so called; thence along the northerly and easterly
36 line of said riverway and the easterly line of Louis
37 Prang street to Huntington avenue; thence along the
38 northerly side of Huntington avenue to its intersec-
39 tion with Massachusetts avenue; thence northerly
40 along the westerly side of Massachusetts avenue to
41 the Charles river basin; thence along the Charles
42 river basin to the point of beginning.
