In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act relative to the Lease of a Court Room and Offices for the Use of the Trial Justice's Court in the Town of Ludlow.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Hamp-
2 den county are hereby authorized to lease, for periods
3 not exceeding three years each, a court room and
4 offices for the use of the trial justice's court in the
5 town of Ludlow in said county, at an aggregate rental
6 not exceeding fifty dollars a month, notwithstanding
7 the provisions of section five of chapter two hundred
8 and nineteen of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance during the current year by the county com-
3 missioners of said county, but not otherwise.
