Buckley that provision be made for adequate financial support for the aviation unit of the National Guard; the petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 95) of William Carroll Hill, president, Aero Club of New England, Inc., that facilities be provided at the airport in East Boston for the aviation units of the National Guard; and the petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 316) of James C. Scanlan that provision be made for the construction of hangars and other necessary equipment and facilities for the state aviation forces, report the accompanying resolve (House, No. 1337).

Resolve providing for the Erection at the Airport in East Boston of a Building for the Use of the Aviation Unit of the Massachusetts National Guard.

1 *Resolved*, That the armory commissioners are hereby
2 authorized and directed to erect, with the approval of
3 the governor and council, a building on land within
4 the limits of the airport in East Boston for use by the
5 aviation unit of the Massachusetts national guard as
6 an administration building and hangar. Said commis-
7 sioners may expend such sum, not exceeding two hun-
8 dred and fifty thousand dollars, as may hereafter be
9 appropriated for this purpose.
