## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

Resolve providing for Additional Band Concerts during the Current Year in Places under the Control of the Metropolitan District Commission.

1 *Resolved*, That the metropolitan district commis-  
2 sion is hereby authorized and directed to provide  
3 band concerts in such parks, parkways or other places  
4 under its control, and at such times during the cur-  
5 rent year as it may select. For the purposes of this  
6 resolve, said commission may expend such sum not  
7 exceeding ten thousand dollars as may hereafter be  
8 appropriated, the same to be in addition to any other  
9 appropriations made for band concerts in places under  
10 its control.
