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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act authorizing the City of Melrose to use Certain  
Park Lands for School Purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Melrose is hereby author-  
2 ized, by and with the consent of its park commission,  
3 to use for school purposes a portion of its undevel-  
4 oped park lands located north of Lynn Fells park-  
5 way in said city and more particularly bounded and  
6 described as follows:— Beginning at a point on the  
7 northerly side of Lynn Fells parkway seven hundred  
8 feet distant in an easterly direction from Tremont  
9 street, thence running in a northerly direction by  
10 land of Melrose Athletic Field Association, Inc. two  
11 hundred feet to land now or formerly of William  
12 Magnar, thence turning and running in an easterly  
13 direction south eighty-nine degrees, fifty-one minutes,  
14 nineteen seconds east by land of said Magnar, and  
15 by land now or formerly of Frank S. Fields and Etta

16 Carruthers, Paulina Spadafora, George F. Damon  
17 and Albert O. Plantinga eight hundred and eighty-  
18 six and six tenths feet to other land of said city of  
19 Melrose, thence turning at an angle and running in  
20 a southerly direction south five degrees, twenty-two  
21 minutes, fifty-three seconds west by land of said city  
22 of Melrose thirteen feet to said Lynn Fells parkway,  
23 thence turning at an angle and running in a westerly  
24 direction in a curved line by said Lynn Fells park-  
25 way nine hundred and nine and eighty-eight hun-  
26 dredths feet to the point of beginning, and thereafter  
27 the portion aforesaid shall be under the same care  
28 and control as other school property.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
