An Act to validate Certain Votes of the Town of Dennis and Certain Acts of its Selectmen.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The vote of the town of Dennis at
2 its annual meeting held March twentieth, nineteen
3 hundred and twenty-three, to have its selectmen act
4 as a board of public welfare and as assessors in said
5 town, so far as such vote was invalid by reason of
6 its failure to comply with the provisions of general
7 laws in effect on said date, is hereby made valid and
8 the acts of its selectmen acting as such board of pub-
9 lic welfare and as assessors between said date and the
10 passage of this act are hereby ratified and confirmed
11 to the same extent as if they had been legally chosen
12 to act as such officers and said selectmen shall con-
13 tinue to act as assessors and as the board of public

14 welfare in said town and shall have all necessary
15 powers therefor until such time as said town by vote
16 in accordance with the provisions of general laws
17 otherwise determines.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
