The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act establishing a State Lottery Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter six of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by adding at the end thereof the following new sec-
3 tions:—

4 *Section 38.* There shall be a state lottery commis-
5 sion consisting of the commissioner of public welfare,
6 the state treasurer and three persons appointed by the
7 governor for the term of three years. The persons
8 appointed by the governor shall receive such compen-
9 sation as the governor and council may determine.

10 *Section 39.* Said commission shall conduct a state
11 lottery, the profits of which shall be paid over to the
12 state treasurer to be used for the purpose of paying
13 the cost of assistance given to certain aged persons
14 under the provisions of chapter one hundred and
15 eighteen A. Said commission may make rules and
16 regulations necessary to carry out the provisions of this
17 section and may employ such clerical and other assist-
18 ance as may be necessary therefor.
