

HOUSE No. 1659

Mr. Rafter of Salem presented a petition of Robert H. Mitchell and others, county commissioners, that the county of Essex be authorized to borrow money for the purpose of constructing an extension of an existing sewer at the Essex County Industrial Farm at Middleton. Counties.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act authorizing the County Commissioners of the County of Essex to borrow Money for the Purpose of Constructing an Extension of an Existing Sewer at the Essex County Industrial Farm at Middleton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. To meet the expenses of constructing
2 an extension of an existing sewer at the Essex county
3 industrial farm at Middleton, the county commis-
4 sioners of the county of Essex may expend a sum not
5 exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes aforesaid, the said
2 commissioners may borrow from time to time, upon
3 the credit of said county, such sums as may be neces-
4 sary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, the said sum of
5 twenty-five hundred dollars, and may issue notes of

6 the county therefor, which shall be payable in not
7 more than one year from their respective dates.
8 Notes issued under authority of this act shall bear
9 on their face the words, County of Essex, Industrial
10 Farm Sewer Loan, Act of 1931, and, except as herein
11 provided, shall be subject to chapter thirty-five of
12 the General Laws. Such notes shall be signed by the
13 treasurer of said county and countersigned by a
14 majority of the county commissioners. Said notes
15 may be sold at a discount, such discount to be treated
16 as interest paid in advance. The county may sell
17 such securities at public or private sale and the pro-
18 ceeds shall be used only for the purposes specified
19 in this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance during the current year by the county
3 commissioners of said county, but not otherwise.
