The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act to establish Congressional Districts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter fifty-seven of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section one and inserting
3 a new section as follows:—

4 *Section 1.* For the purpose of electing representa-
5 tives in the Congress of the United States, until
6 otherwise provided by law, the commonwealth is
7 divided into the following fifteen districts, each of
8 which shall elect one representative:

9 Number One,— Consisting of North Adams,
10 Pittsfield and the towns in Berkshire County; Ash-
11 field, Bernardston, Buckland, Charlemont, Colrain,
12 Conway, Deerfield, Erving, Gill, Greenfield, Hawley,
13 Heath, Leverett, Leyden, Monroe, Montague, New
14 Salem, Northfield, Orange, Rowe, Shelburne, Shutes-
15 bury, Sunderland, Warwick, Wendell and Whately
16 in Franklin County; Blandford, Chester, Gran-
17 ville, Holyoke, Montgomery, Russell, Southwick,

18 Tolland and Westfield in Hampden County; Am-
19 herst, Belchertown, Chesterfield, Cummington, En-
20 field, Goshen, Granby, Greenwich, Huntington,
21 Middlefield, Pelham, Plainfield, Prescott, Southamp-
22 ton, Westhampton, Williamsburg and Worthington
23 in Hampshire County; and Athol and Royalston
24 in Worcester County.

25 Number Two, — Consisting of Agawam, Chicopee,
26 East Longmeadow, Hampden, Longmeadow, Lud-
27 low, Springfield, West Springfield and Wilbraham
28 in Hampden County; and Easthampton, Hadley,
29 Hatfield, Northampton and South Hadley in Hamp-
30 shire County.

31 Number Three, — Consisting of Ashburnham,
32 Barre, Berlin, Bolton, Brookfield, Charlton, Clinton,
33 Dana, Dudley, East Brookfield, Fitchburg, Gard-
34 ner, Hardwick, Harvard, Hubbardston, Lancaster,
35 Leicester, Leominster, Lunenburg, New Braintree,
36 North Brookfield, Oakham, Oxford, Paxton, Peters-
37 ham, Phillipston, Princeton, Rutland, Southbridge,
38 Spencer, Sterling, Sturbridge, Templeton, Warren,
39 Webster, West Brookfield, Westminster and Win-
40 chendon in Worcester County; Ware in Hampshire
41 County; Brimfield, Holland, Monson, Palmer and
42 Wales in Hampden County; and Ashby, Boxborough,
43 Framingham, Hudson, Marlborough, Maynard, Shir-
44 ley, Stow, Sudbury and Townsend in Middlesex
45 County.

46 Number Four,— Consisting of Auburn, Black-
47 stone, Boylston, Douglas, Grafton, Holden, Hope-
48 dale, Mendon, Milford, Millbury, Millville, North-
49 borough, Northbridge, Shrewsbury, Southborough,
50 Sutton, Upton, Uxbridge, Westborough, West Boyls-
51 ton and Worcester in Worcester County.

52 Number Five, — Consisting of Acton, Ayer, Bed-
53 ford, Billerica, Burlington, Carlisle, Chelmsford,
54 Dracut, Dunstable, Groton, Littleton, Lowell,
55 Malden, Melrose, Pepperell, Reading, Stoneham,
56 Tewksbury, Tyngsborough, Wakefield, Westford,
57 Wilmington and Woburn in Middlesex County.

58 Number Six, — Consisting of Amesbury, Beverly,
59 Boxford, Danvers, Essex, Georgetown, Gloucester,
60 Groveland, Hamilton, Haverhill, Ipswich, Manches-
61 ter, Marblehead, Merrimac, Methuen, Middleton,
62 Newbury, Newburyport, North Andover, Rockport,
63 Rowley, Salem, Salisbury, Swampscott, Topsfield,
64 Wenham and West Newbury in Essex County.

65 Number Seven, — Consisting of Andover, Law-
66 rence, Lynn, Lynnfield, Nahant, Peabody and Saugus
67 in Essex County; North Reading in Middlesex
68 County, and Revere and Winthrop in Suffolk County.

69 Number Eight, — Consisting of Cambridge, Med-
70 ford and Somerville in Middlesex County.

71 Number Nine, — Consisting of Arlington, Bel-
72 mont, Concord, Lexington, Lincoln, Newton, Wal-
73 tham, Watertown, Wayland, Weston and Winchester
74 in Middlesex County; and Brookline in Norfolk
75 County.

76 Number Ten, — Consisting of wards numbered
77 four, five, nine, ten, eleven and precincts numbered
78 two, five, six, seven, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen,
79 fourteen and fifteen in ward numbered twelve and
80 wards numbered nineteen, twenty, twenty-one and
81 twenty-two in Boston in Suffolk County.

82 Number Eleven, — Consisting of wards numbered
83 one, two, three and eight in Boston in Suffolk County;
84 Chelsea in Suffolk County; and Everett in Middle-
85 sex County.

86 Number Twelve, — Consisting of wards numbered
87 six and seven, and precincts numbered one, three,
88 four, eight and nine in ward numbered twelve, and
89 wards thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen
90 and eighteen in Boston in Suffolk County.

91 Number Thirteen, — Consisting of Avon, Belling-
92 ham, Braintree, Canton, Dedham, Dover, Fox-
93 borough, Franklin, Holbrook, Medfield, Medway,
94 Millis, Milton, Needham, Norfolk, Norwood, Plain-
95 ville, Quincy, Randolph, Sharon, Stoughton, Wal-
96 pole, Wellesley, Westwood, Weymouth and Wren-
97 tham in Norfolk County; and Ashland, Holliston,
98 Hopkinton, Sherborn and Natick in Middlesex
99 County.

100 Number Fourteen, — Consisting of Attleboro,
101 Dartmouth, Fall River, New Bedford, North Attle-
102 borough, Rehoboth, Seekonk, Somerset, Swansea
103 and Westport in Bristol County.

104 Number Fifteen, — Consisting of Abington,
105 Bridgewater, Brockton, Carver, Duxbury, East
106 Bridgewater, Halifax, Hanover, Hanson, Hingham,
107 Hull, Kingston, Lakeville, Marion, Marshfield, Mat-
108 tapoisett, Middleborough, Norwell, Pembroke, Plym-
109 outh, Plympton, Rochester, Rockland, Scituate,
110 Wareham, West Bridgewater and Whitman in
111 Plymouth County; Chilmark, Edgartown, Gay
112 Head, Gosnold, Oak Bluffs, Tisbury and West
113 Tisbury in Dukes County; Barnstable, Bourne,
114 Brewster, Chatham, Dennis, Eastham, Falmouth,
115 Harwich, Mashpee, Orleans, Provincetown, Sand-
