
By Mr. Soble of Boston, petition of Francis X. Tyrrell that provision be made for painting of murals (under direction of the Art Commission and the Governor and Council) on the westerly wall of the Chamber of the House of Representatives depicting early events in the history of the General Court. State Administration.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

Resolve providing for the Painting of Murals in the Five Panels on the Westerly Wall of the Chamber of the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved*, That, in commemoration of the estab-
2 lishment of the general court of Massachusetts, it is
3 hereby directed that fitting murals, depicting five
4 outstanding events connected with the early history
5 of said general court, be painted in the five large
6 panels on the westerly wall of the chamber of the
7 house of representatives. For this purpose such
8 sum, not to exceed thirty thousand dollars, as may
9 hereafter be appropriated may be expended by the
10 governor and the executive council. The art com-
11 mission of the commonwealth may assist the gov-
12 ernor and the executive council in selecting and de-
13 termining the events to be so depicted and arrange
14 for the painting of said murals and the placing
15 thereof as aforesaid.
