

By Mr. O'Dea of Northampton, petition of Stillman D. Hitchcock and others that the Mount Tom State Reservation Commission be authorized to acquire additional land adjoining the reservation. Harbors and Public Lands.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

An Act to provide for Enlarging the Mount Tom State Reservation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Mount Tom state reservation commission is
2 hereby authorized to acquire by purchase, or by
3 right of eminent domain, such land adjoining the
4 reservation as the commission may deem it expedient
5 to acquire; and may expend from the treasury of
6 the commonwealth for this purpose a sum not ex-
7 ceeding five hundred dollars. The provisions of
8 chapter two hundred and sixty-four of the acts of
9 the year nineteen hundred and three shall apply to
10 the land acquired hereunder, and to the purchase
11 or taking thereof.
