The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

Resolve in Favor of the Heirs of Joan Arc Ransom.

1 *Resolved*, That subject to appropriation there
2 be allowed and paid from the treasury of the com-
3 monwealth, under the direction of the attorney
4 general, to the heirs at law or next of kin of Joan
5 Arc Ransom, who died in the town of Mattapoisett,
6 in the year nineteen hundred and ten, or to their
7 lawful representatives, such sum as may be found
8 by the attorney general to have been paid into said
9 treasury as the balance of the assets belonging to
10 the estate of said Joan Arc Ransom, under the pro-
11 visions of section ten of chapter one hundred and
12 ninety-four of the General Laws, notwithstanding
13 the expiration of the time limited by said section
14 for the recovery of such sum.
