## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

---

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

---

An Act providing for Full Illumination of Through Ways.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The commissioner of public works is  
2 hereby authorized to prepare plans for the illumina-  
3 tion of the through ways of the commonwealth of  
4 such a character and of sufficient lighting power as  
5 to make the use of head lamps on motor vehicles  
6 unnecessary.

1 SECTION 2. Subject to the approval of the gov-  
2 ernor and council the commissioner may enter into  
3 contracts with manufacturers for equipment and  
4 erection of lights and with electric power companies  
5 for electric current, and for the maintenance of said  
6 lights.

1 SECTION 3. The commissioner is authorized to  
2 enter into contracts during the year nineteen hun-  
3 dred and thirty-two for not in excess of one million,  
4 five hundred thousand dollars, which shall be taken  
5 from the Highway Fund.

1 SECTION 4. The commissioner is authorized to  
2 contract with cities, towns and counties for part pay-  
3 ment for the lighting of such portions of highways  
4 as after conference with boards or commissioners  
5 may be determined to be equitable.
