The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

An Act relative to the Retirement of Municipal Employees of Cities operating under Plan B Charters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The heads of departments or members
2 of municipal boards having charge of employees may
3 retire from service subject to the approval of the
4 mayor any employee who has arrived at the age of
5 sixty years.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
