1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of
2 the treasury of the commonwealth the sum of
3 dollars to Mrs. Janet I. Edmunds for the
4 death of her husband who was killed while in the
5 discharge of military duty at Camp Devens, July
6 nineteen, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, as a
7 member of company A, one hundred and first en-
8 gineers, twenty-sixth division, Massachusetts national
9 guard.
