

HOUSE No. 992

By Messrs. MacLeod of Chelsea and Doyle of Malden, petition of John W. MacLeod and William H. Doyle that the Department of Public Health be authorized to abate certain nuisances caused by industrial plants along Mystic River in the cities of Chelsea and Everett. Public Health.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

An Act to provide for the Abatement of Certain Nuisances caused by Industrial Plants in the Cities of Chelsea and Everett.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public health is
2 hereby directed to take such action as may be neces-
3 sary to abate the nuisances caused by the odors, dust,
4 smoke and dirt emanating from industrial plants in the
5 cities of Chelsea and Everett on or near the banks of
6 the Mystic river.

1 SECTION 2. Said department may expend, for the
2 purposes of this act, such sums, not exceeding seven
3 thousand five hundred dollars, as may be appropriated
4 by the general court.
