## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

An Act establishing the Office of Second Assistant Clerk in the Municipal Court of the Brighton District of the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section ten of chapter two hundred  
2 and eighteen of the General Laws, as most recently  
3 amended by section one of chapter one hundred and  
4 fifty-two of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty,  
5 is hereby further amended by inserting after the word  
6 "district" in the nineteenth line the words:—, the  
7 municipal court of the Brighton district,— so as to  
8 read as follows:— *Section 10.* The clerk of a district  
9 court may, subject to the approval of the justice,  
10 appoint one or more assistant clerks, who shall be  
11 removable at his pleasure or at the pleasure of the  
12 court, for whose official acts the clerk shall be re-  
13 sponsible and who shall be paid by him unless salaries

14 payable by the county are authorized in this section  
15 or in section fifty-three. Assistant clerks with salaries  
16 payable by the county may be appointed in the cen-  
17 tral district court of northern Essex, the municipal  
18 court of the Charlestown district, the municipal court  
19 of the Brighton district, the district court of western  
20 Hampden, the district court of Newton, the district  
21 court of northern Norfolk and in courts the judicial  
22 districts of which have, according to the national or  
23 state census last preceding, a population of sixty  
24 thousand or more. Second assistant clerks with  
25 salaries payable by the county may be appointed in  
26 the municipal court of the Roxbury district, the East  
27 Boston district court, the municipal court of the  
28 Charlestown district, the municipal court of the Dor-  
29 chester district, the municipal court of the Brighton  
30 district, the municipal court of the West Roxbury  
31 district, and, subject to the approval of the county  
32 commissioners, in the first district court of eastern  
33 Middlesex, the third district court of eastern Middle-  
34 sex, the district court of southern Essex, the third  
35 district court of Bristol and the district court of East  
36 Norfolk.

37 Third assistant clerks with salaries payable by the  
38 county may be appointed in the municipal court of  
39 the Roxbury district and, subject to the approval of  
40 the county commissioners, in the first district court  
41 of eastern Middlesex and the third district court of  
42 eastern Middlesex.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of the city  
3 council of the city of Boston, subject to the provisions  
4 of its charter but not otherwise.
