

HOUSE No. 1088

By Mr. Hennigan of Boston, petition of James W. Hennigan relative to the salary of the senior court officer of the municipal court of the Roxbury district of the city of Boston. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

An Act relative to the Salary of the Senior Court Officer of the Municipal Court of the Roxbury District in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section forty-nine of chapter thirty-five of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by section
3 eight of chapter three hundred and one of the acts of
4 nineteen hundred and thirty-one, is hereby further
5 amended by inserting after the word "classification"
6 in the fifteenth line, as printed in section one of chapter
7 two hundred and fifty-four of the acts of nineteen
8 hundred and thirty-one, the following: — ; provided,
9 that in such classification the maximum salary of the
10 senior court officer in attendance upon the municipal
11 court of the Roxbury district shall be equal to the
12 maximum salary of the senior court officer in attend-
13 ance upon the municipal court of the city of Boston, —
14 so that the first sentence of said section forty-nine will

15 read as follows:— *Section 49.* Every office and
16 position whereof the salary is wholly payable from the
17 treasury of one or more counties, or from funds admin-
18 istered by and through county officials, except the
19 offices of county commissioners and associate county
20 commissioners, justices and special justices of the dis-
21 trict courts, clerks and assistant clerks of the district
22 courts other than the municipal court of the city of
23 Boston, trial justices, other offices and positions filled
24 by appointment of the governor with the advice and
25 consent of the council, and probation officers, shall be
26 classified by the board in the manner provided by
27 sections forty-eight to fifty-six, inclusive, and every
28 such office and position, now existing or hereafter
29 established, shall be allocated by the board to its proper
30 place in such classification; provided, that in such
31 classification the maximum salary of the senior court
32 officer in attendance upon the municipal court of the
33 Roxbury district shall be equal to the maximum
34 salary of the senior court officer in attendance upon the
35 municipal court of the city of Boston.
