An Act relative to Employment of Prison Labor at the State Prison Colony in the Town of Norfolk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 After the effective date of this act, no prisoners
- 2 shall be employed in the construction or completion
- 3 of any building at the state prison colony in the
