Resolve reviving and continuing the Special Commission established to Revise and Recodify the Laws relating to Co-operative Banks.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission,
2 established by chapter twenty-nine of the resolves of
3 nineteen hundred and thirty-one for the purpose of
4 revising and recodifying the laws relating to co-opera-
5 tive banks, is hereby revived and continued, and the
6 final report of said commission, together with drafts
7 of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations
8 into effect, shall be filed with the clerk of the house of
9 representatives on or before the first Wednesday of
10 December in the current year. The unexpended bal-
11 ance of the amount appropriated by item thirty-six F
12 of chapter four hundred and sixty of the acts of nine-
13 teen hundred and thirty-one is hereby made available
14 for the purposes of this resolve.
