In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

An Act relative to Appointment of an Acting Business Manager of the School Committee of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter three hundred and eighteen of
2 the acts of nineteen hundred and six, as amended in
3 section one by chapter one hundred and forty of the
4 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-six, is hereby
5 further amended by striking out said section one and
6 inserting in place thereof the following: —

7 *Section 1.* The school committee of the city of
8 Boston shall choose a secretary, not of their own num-
9 ber, who shall also serve as secretary to the board of
10 superintendents, and a business manager, who shall
11 hold their respective offices until removed by the
12 committee for cause. Said committee may also
13 choose, and may for cause remove, an acting business
14 manager who shall serve only during the absence or
15 inability to act of the business manager and shall
16 during such time exercise all the powers and perform
17 all the duties of said business manager. The com-
18 mittee may also elect and remove such other subordi-
19 nate officers not specifically provided for by law as

20 they may deem expedient. The business manager
21 shall in writing approve and transmit to the auditor
22 of said city all vouchers, pay rolls and other documents
23 calling for the expenditure of money, together with
24 summarized requisitions on said auditor, approved by
25 the committee or by any authorized member thereof,
26 and requesting said auditor to place said vouchers,
27 pay rolls and other documents on his draft for pay-
28 ment by the treasurer of said city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
