Resolve in Favor of Herman Lind of Middleborough and  
Emil A. Rinne of Middleborough.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging the  
2 moral obligations in the premises, and after an ap-  
3 propriation has been made from the Highway Fund,  
4 there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the  
5 commonwealth to Herman Lind, of Middleborough,  
6 the sum of eighteen hundred and forty-four dollars,  
7 and to Emil A. Rinne, of Middleborough, the sum of  
8 thirteen hundred and nine dollars, in full compensa-  
9 tion for damages sustained as a result of the con-  
10 struction of a state highway in the town of Middle-  
11 borough.
