

By Mr. Otis of Pittsfield, petition of Frank Howard and others relative to appropriations by the county of Berkshire for Mount Greylock State Reservation and for a reserve fund. Counties.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

An Act making Certain Appropriations for the Maintenance of Berkshire County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section two of chapter two hundred and twenty-  
2 eight of the current year is hereby amended by strik-  
3 ing out, under the heading "Berkshire County" item  
4 twenty-one and inserting in place thereof the follow-  
5 ing:—

6 21 For the care and maintenance of Grey-  
7 lock state reservation, a sum not ex-  
8 ceeding eight thousand dollars, of  
9 which a sum not exceeding thirty-five  
10 hundred dollars together with further  
11 sums received from private contri-  
12 butions may be expended for the erec-  
13 tion of a summit house on Mount  
14 Greylock . . . . . 8,000 00

15 and by striking out item twenty-four and inserting in  
16 place thereof the following:—

17 24 For a reserve fund, a sum not exceeding  
18 seven thousand dollars . . . . . 7,000 00
