An Act restoring to District Attorneys Certain Powers with Respect to the Disposition of Complaints or Indictments for the Violation of Provisions of Law relative to Intoxicating Liquors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section seventy-seven of chapter one hundred and
- 2 thirty-eight of the General Laws is hereby repealed.
