

By Mr. Barry of Boston, petition of George F. Murphy that salaries of elected state officers, members of the Council and members of the General Court be increased. Ways and Means (Joint).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act increasing the Compensation of Certain Elected State Officials.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The compensation of the governor,
2 lieutenant governor, attorney general, secretary of
3 state, state treasurer and receiver general, and state
4 auditor shall be increased by at least twenty-five per
5 cent over the present compensation per annum.

1 SECTION 2. The compensation of the members of
2 the executive council shall hereafter be twenty-five
3 hundred dollars per annum.

1 SECTION 3. The compensation of state senators
2 and representatives shall be twenty-five hundred
3 dollars per annum, without further compensation for
4 extra sessions.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
