To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in General Court assembled.

In accordance with section 6 of chapter 3 of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 51 of the Acts of 1923, and by chapter 170 of the Acts of 1924, the Department of Education transmits herewith the petition and accompanying bill of Horatio S. Card for authority for Middlesex College of Medicine and Surgery to grant the degree of Doctor of Dental Medicine.

The Department of Education respectfully recommends that the petition for the Middlesex College of Medicine and Surgery for authority to confer the degree of Doctor of Dental Medicine be not granted.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act authorizing the Middlesex College of Medicine and Surgery, Inc., to confer the Degree of Doctor of Dental Medicine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Middlesex College of Medicine
2 and Surgery, Inc., a corporation incorporated under
3 chapter twenty-eight of the acts of eighteen hun-
4 dred and forty-nine under the name of the Worcester
5 Medical Institution, and whose name was changed
6 to its present one under General Law, December
7 fifteen, nineteen hundred and fourteen, is hereby au-
8 thorized to grant the degree of doctor of dental
9 medicine to students properly accredited and recog-
10 nized by a majority of its trustees, provided that
11 the course of instruction furnished by the corporation
12 shall occupy not less than four years of thirty-two
13 weeks each.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
